FRENCH LICK, Ind. – The Indiana State School Music Association's (ISSMA) version of the State Marching Band Tournament begins this weekend with the District Competition.

Most of the area marching bands will travel to Jasper High School's Alumni Stadium for their District event. To advance to regional, bands must score above a per-determined benchmark. Those advancing will receive a Gold rating.

The Springs Valley Blackhawk Brigade looks to make a 27th appearance at Regional and 7th consecutive trip. The Brigade takes the field at 11:13 am.

The Pride of Paoli will kick off the day, taking the field at 11:00 am. Northeast Dubois will perform at 11:52 am while Orleans will begin their show at 1:23 pm. Awards at Jasper are scheduled for approximately 2:05 pm.

The Crawford County Wolfpack Band will head up I-65 and perform at the Columbus East District. They will take the field at 12:15 pm.

In the latest Indiana Marching.com Class 'D' Writer's Poll, the Orange County schools again were prevalent in the polls. Springs Valley remains atop the poll for the third consecutive week. Paoli and Orleans both remained in sixth and eighth respectively. The Pride and Regiment have clung to those positions all year.
