FRENCH LICK, Ind. – Now that the regular season is over, all local bands have turned their attention to Evansville Central High School and the Indiana State School Music Association (ISSMA) Class D South Regional.

Springs Valley enters the weekend looking to advanced past regional for the fourth consecutive year. They take the field at 1:18 pm Eastern Daylight Time.

The Pride of Paoli will perform at 2:23 pm as they look to advanced past Regional for the third consecutive year and the seventh time in the last eight years.

The Orleans Bulldog Regiment will take the field at 1:57 pm in hopes of making back-to-back trips to Semi-State.

The Crawford County Wolfpack Band, in their fourth competitive season, is looking to continue on a storybook season and advance to semi-state for the first time.
